Instructions

- 1. Licensee must notify the OFFICE OF THE COMMISSIONER OF FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS **30 days** prior to terminating business under this license outside NMLS.
- 2. Upon surrender, licensee must submit a surrender request through NMLS.
- 3. The licensee must submit any documents required on the checklist below with this checklist within 5 business days of the electronic submission of your surrender through the NMLS at the following:
