These release notes describe the enhancements for Release 2009.4 of the Nationwide Mortgage Licensing System (NMLS), released on September 14, 2009. Release 2009.4 is comprised mainly of renewals enhancements. The renewals enhancements were crafted to address industry and regulator issues that were identified from several sources. SRR collected industry feedback from a renewals survey, input from the Industry Development Working Group and from issues handled by the NMLS Call Center. Regulators responded to an e-mail request for suggested renewals enhancements and also provided feedback through the NMLS Call Center and other sources.

249797	Update Text of Renewals System Notifications	System notifications specific to Renewals have been updated for clarity.
249649	Streamline the Renewals Process	The Company renewals process has been greatly simplified so that the separate step of reviewing renewal requests will no longer be required prior to confirming selections. In addition, the separate pay and review roles are being removed which will allow any user with a renewal role to submit and pay for renewals. Users previously granted these roles will automatically be assigned the single renewal role with the release. Company and branch attestation will be included as part of the Renewals Cart submission and will cover any company or branch renewal requests included in the submission. Company Users will not have to identify each jurisdiction that they are attesting for. After licenses are selected for renewal, the user can immediately pay for renewal requests from the Renewals Cart. Carts will continue to be user specific.
		The Renewal Selection list will default to show all renewable company, branch and sponsored individual licenses. The "Do Not Pay" option for individual licenses will be removed and Mortgage Loan Originators will be able to renew their own licenses without the Company first delegating renewal control to the Individual. Individual attestation will remain unchanged and will remain at the jurisdiction level. Individual users must attest to their licenses before they can be submitted for renewal. Attestation for Individuals will open at the start of the renewal period (November 1 st).
