Who Is Required to Have This License?

All sole proprietors, corporations, limited liability companies, partnerships, or other entities engaging in the business of money transmission or advertising, soliciting, or holding out as providing money transmission services. Delegates may be authorized by the holder of a money transmission license.

See Alaska Statute <u>Chapter 06.55 Alaska Uniform Money Services Act</u> and (3 AAC 13) under <u>Alaska Administrative Code</u>: Title 3, Chapter 13.

Alaska Division of Banking & Securities does not issue paper licenses for this license type.

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Pre-Requisites for License Applications

- Net Worth \$25,000
- Due to the volatile nature of cryptocurrencies, the Division of Banking & Securities determined that
 in order to ensure proper consumer protection for the residents of Alaska, virtual currency
 applicants are to acquire an Electronic Surety Bond of \$500,000.00, in accordance with <u>AS</u>
 06.55.104(f).
- Criminal Background Checks must be acquired <u>prior</u> to submitting an application, from all countries
 lived in for all control persons that meet the following criteria: Foreign nationals currently residing
 in the US, individuals who do not currently reside in the US, or individuals who have lived outside
 the US in the past 10 years.

Alaska Money Transmitter license does not grant the authority to the licensee to engage in rehypothecation or other lending practices of consumer held cryptocurrencies.

Document Uploads Guidance

Documents that must be uploaded to the *Document Uploads* section of the Company Form (MU1) in NMLS are indicated in the checklist below. When uploading documents:

- Follow the guidance in Document Upload Descriptions and Examples.
- Only upload documents relevant to the company application.
- Only upload documents where there is a selectable document category. If inappropriate documents
 are uploaded that should not be, you will be contacted by your regulator and asked to remove them
 from NMLS.
- Do not upload the same company documents multiple times. Generally, unless the document is state-specific, if the document has already been uploaded for another state, a new upload is not required unless changes have been made.
- If a document previously uploaded has been revised, delete the old document and replace it with the new document (history of the old document will remain in NMLS).
- For state-specific documents (e.g., Surety Bonds), be sure to indicate the applicable state.
