## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

According to Ohio Revised Code Section 1315.18, a licensee that ceases to do business in this state shall do so in accordance with a plan approved by the superintendent of financial institutions or pursuant to directions issued by the superintendent in connection with the revocation or suspension of the licensee's license pursuant to section 1315.151 of the Revised Code.

When a licensee ceases to do business in this state, if the superintendent considers it necessary to protect the interests of the licensee's customers, the superintendent may do either of the following:

- Take control of permissible investments or other assets owned by the licensee equal in value to the licensee's outstandings in this state;
- Require the sale of the licensee's contracts for continuing services or require the licensee's termination of those contracts with compensation to the customers for loss of the services.

#### Instruction

- 1. File the surrender request through NMLS.
- 2. There is no fee to surrender.
- 3. Obtain Ohio Division of Financial Institution's approval to surrender. We may request additional information upon review of your surrender.

	<b>Return Original License:</b> Company is required to return its original license once the Ohio Division of Financial Institutions approves the surrender.	Mail to Ohio Division of Financial Institutions.	
	<b>Surety Bond Determination:</b> In order to be released, the Company must provide documentation (i.e. balance sheet and database records) evidencing that the Ohio customer outstandings have been extinguished.	Mail to Ohio Division of Financial Institutions.	

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
